Preventing Suspensions and Expulsions

No one wants to suspend or expel a child from their program. The goal is to find ways to help children be successful, ensure a safe environment, and help you feel empowered as childcare providers. Together we'll consider the impact of relationships, environment, schedule, and interactions on children's behavior as well as the role of implicit bias. Utilizing scenarios and small group discussion, we will reflect on ways you can apply the Steps to Prevent Suspensions/Expulsions tool in order to build your capacity and respond to children and their families with wisdom and compassion, and how and when to seek help from outside sources. —Participants must attend both sessions to receive credit.—

Understanding Children's Temperament

Temperament is a way children respond to the world. It influences the way children handle emotions, regulate behavior, feel around new people and adapt to new situations. You can nurture a child's development by using strategies that suit their temperaments. Nevertheless, the behavioral adjustment of young children depends a lot on the interaction between their temperament and yours and how others respond to them - how comfortably they fit within their environment and the people around them. We will explore children's temperament and how to respond.
